The Purpose of the Pupil Development Grant is to improve the educational attainment of pupils from low income families and who are entitled to free school meals (eFSM). Schools are expected to maximise the use of this funding by introducing sustainable strategies which will quickly lead to improved outcomes for pupils entitled to free school meals.

At Wrexham Early Years Centre we:

- plan interventions that focus on improving the attainment of pupils from deprived backgrounds, regularly monitoring pupil progress and evaluating the impact of the intervention.
- integrate plans for the effective use of the grant into the School Development Plan, basing our practice on sound evidence and including them as part of a whole school strategy.
- balance whole school strategies with targeted interventions to ensure that all learners entitled to free school meals benefit as individuals, whilst the whole school also develops its ability to support every learner to achieve their full potential.

Wrexham Early Years Centre has been allocated a total Pupil Development Grant of £4,200, for 2019 - 2020.

The funding will be used to:

- part fund a member of staff to work with children and families in aspects of well being - £2,582
- purchase resources to support children's communication skills - £1,318
- purchase digital technology to explore aspects of Pupil Voice - £300
