



Dear Parents / Carers

We have had confirmation today that our children will now start returning to school. It will be so nice to see them again after such a long time away from the classroom. We are now thinking very carefully about how we can further protect our children and staff when we're all back in school. We want to help reassure you, by letting you know that we are following Welsh Government, Public Health Wales and Local Authority advice and guidance in order to ensure that the learning environment is as Covid secure as possible.

Here are some of the additional measures we are putting in place in order to make the school a safer place for all members of the school community.

- Staff to wear a high quality, 3 layer face covering, when appropriate.
- All staff will be allocated two lateral flow tests per week to test themselves at home.
- We will ensure that the classrooms are very well ventilated throughout the day.
- Outdoor learning and play will be maximised in the weeks to come.
- Enhanced frequent cleaning of resources, furniture, door handles etc will be taking place, several times a day and soft equipment and items such as cushions will be removed for the time being.
- We will be maintaining social distancing whenever possible.
- We aim to stagger the children's entry in to school (those who arrive on foot and by taxi) so that they avoid any possible crowding as they enter and leave school.
- School will be managing risk by keeping children and staff in bubbles and will try, as far as possible, to keep the same children and staff members together from day to day.
- Frequent handwashing and use of hand sanitiser - adults only- will be encouraged.
- Updating all policies, procedures and risk assessments relating to Covid 19.

Please could you help us by:

- always wearing a face mask when you enter the school grounds.
- keeping a two metre social distance from escorts, drivers, other parents and school staff at all times.
- whenever possible, could only one person drop off and collect their child. We are trying to keep the number of people on the school grounds to a minimum.

If your child is unwell, it is **extremely important** that you keep them at home. If they become unwell in school, you will need to come and collect them as soon as possible.
